Maureen Bergeson introduced our speaker, Adam Lauwers, son of Kiwanian Marsha Dawson. Adam is the UPS Hub & Airport Operations Manager at the Decatur Hub and

Peoria airport.

UPS started in 1907 in Seattle, Washington as United Parcel Service. Louisville, Kentucky is UPS' world hub. It employs over 500,00 people, does business in over 200 countires, and flies over 2,000 daily flight segments. UPS is the 6<sup>th</sup> largest airline in the world transporting 24.5 million packages per day. It's peak time is Thanksgiving through year-end. They hire 100,000 seasonal employees to handle the doubled volume of packages.

UPS also has a Heathcare Division. They are responsible for delivering temperature and time sensitive cargo such as COVID vaccines, human organs for transplant, etc.



The following items of business were conducted:

- 1. <u>Minutes of September Board Meeting</u> David Butler made a motion that the minutes be approved as presented. Carol Martin seconded the motion and it was approved. Copy of Board meeting minutes are included in Board Meeting Documents under "Board Reports" in the "Members Area."
- 2. <u>Secretary's Monthly Reports</u> The Board meeting packet included the monthly volunteer hours report and the KI monthly report. Hours reported were 738 service hours. The top two volunteers were Jeannie Craddock and Tim Hoel. Ian Rominger made a motion to approve the reports as presented. Tim Hoel seconded the motion, and it was approved. Copies of Secretary Reports are included in Board Meeting Documents under "Board Reports" in the "Members Area."
- 3. <u>Treasurer's Monthly Reports</u> The Board packet included copies of the club and foundation monthly treasurer's reports ending September 30, 2023, the Kiwanis end of fiscal year. The current balance for the club was \$14,271.07 and the foundation balance was \$16,153.11. David Butler made a motion to approve the reports as presented. Jeannie Craddock seconded the motion, and it was approved. Copies of treasurer reports are included in Board Meeting Documents under "Board Reports" in the "Members Area."

Tim Hoel made a motion to approve the above disbursements. Carol Martin seconded the motion, and it was approved.

5. New Donation Requests - None

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

- 1. New Member Recruitment Results As of 9/30/23, the club's membership was +1. All 2022/2023 Distinguished Club criteria were met.
- 2. <u>Key Club</u> Jeannie Craddock reported that Jessie Hanner and she are working on changing the volunteer hours deadline so the presentation for the Key Club Volunteer of the Month could have less delay.
- 3. <u>Homecoming Pancake Breakfast</u> The club netted \$1,067.99. Janet sent a Gift-in-Kind thank you letter to Country Salvage. It was agreed that we want to go back to the same pancake mix as we used before. Going forward into 2024, Kim Higgins will be the chairperson for the club's pancake breakfasts, with guidance from Pat Damler when needed. For future breakfasts, the serving hours will be 7:30a-10:30a.
- 4. <u>Kiwanis Kids Days</u> October 27 & 28 Janet reported that the Tootsie Roll Mini Pops have arrived and delivered to Carol Burwash. Online signup is active. Hardcopy signup will be passed around beginning 10/11.
- 5. <u>2023/2024 Budget</u> Jeannie Craddock made a motion to approve the budget as presented. Carol Martin seconded the motion and it was approved. Janet also discussed the 2022/2023 budget to actuals, noting that actual was very close to the budget. The club and foundation are fiscally strong. (Copies enclosed.)

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

- 1. <u>Tuscola Halloween Boo Bash/Trunk or Treat</u> The library and city are holding the event Tuesday, October 24 from 5p-7p. Our club will be represented at Trunk or Treat. After the meeting, David Butler volunteered as chairperson. He needs just a couple of volunteers to help him. Contact David if you're interested in volunteering. We have some candy leftover from Homecoming. If we think we need more, we'll reach out via email to bring to our Oct 18 club meeting.
- 2. <u>Governor's Visit</u> Janet reported that the multi-division visit is November 5 at 2p in Jacksonville. She sent an email with all the details Oct 5. It's about a 2 hour+ drive.

The program will be the Kiwanis Neuroscience Research Foundation. It's \$10 at the door. We have 4 members going so it qualifies as an interclub. Everyone is welcome. Janet must provide the planners with the Tuscola headcount by October 18, so if you plan to go, let her know no later than our club meeting on October 18.

- 3. New Project Proposal Glen Simpson proposed a service project with the goal of improving the NW Student Pickup Station process, making it easier for everyone. The Board approved by motion from Glen and seconded by Julie Slaughter for Glen to form a committee and explore possible solutions, working with Principal Wallace and appropriate school staff and/or board.
- 4. <u>Christmastown</u> The Board agreed that the club would again have a table at the Christmastown vendor event. Kim Higgins will check with Elaine Bryant and Debbie Graber to see if they want to co-chair the bake portion of the table.
- 5. <u>I-I Divisions 25 & 27 Merger</u> It's official. As of October 1, 2024 our club will be in Division 25 with Champaign-Urbana, Danville, Decatur Golden K, and Decatur Early Birds. In this consolidation, there will be no clubs in Division 27. By January 31, 2024 the "new" division 25 must elect a new 2024/2025 Lt. Governor or the current Governor will appoint one. Doug Fink and Doug Warren have scheduled a division council meeting for January 14, 2024 at 1:30PM at the Tuscola United Methodist Church. Janet asked Board members to consider whether we will put forth any Amador nominations at the January council meeting. The decision will be made at the November board meeting.
- 6. <u>2023/2024 Distinguished Club Criteria</u> Gov. Tom Willis has issued the 2023/2024 Distinguished Club criteria. In addition to the usual distinguished criteria, Tom has added an additional level...Distinguished "MAD" (Making A Difference) Criteria. One of the requirements to meet the "MAD" criteria is to sponsor a new Kiwanis Club. The board will review and discuss at our next meeting. (Copy enclosed.)

<u>Next Board Meeting</u> – The next Board meeting will be Monday, November 13, 2023 at noon at Ta'Carbon.
