Jerry Reynolds introduced our speaker, Dr. Bill Hemmer. Bill spoke on a number of health issues.

The cartilage in your

knees only gets lubricated and nutrition when you move. So keep hydrated and moving. For hydration, you should drink half your body weight in ounces per day. Use sea salt (contains potassium and magnesium) verses regular table salt. Put a pinch of sea salt in your drinking water container.

Type 3 diabetes is diabetes of the brain, and is a precursor to dementia and Alzheimer's. To stay healthier, control your blood sugar levels, eat more good fat (extra virgin olive oil, avocado, bacon, butter as example), and keep away from refined sugar. Consider intermittent fasting if you don't have high/low sugar issues and still have your gallbladder.

It helps you to keep healthy if you can sleep 7-8 hours a night. This not only gives your organs and body a rest, but also time to repair cells.
